Situation Summary

Hurricane Irma remains a very powerful hurricane with sustain winds of 120 miles per hour and over 300 miles wide. The official forecast track has shifted west since the previous briefing projecting the Hurricane to make landfall as a Category 4 storm in southwest Florida and moving up the west coast of the state before making an additional westward turn. While the track has shifted, due to the size of the storm, the Triad may still receive adverse weather impacts beginning Monday through Tuesday evening.

North Carolina has declared a State of Emergency for all of North Carolina and North Carolina Emergency Management is activating resources to support local operations over the weekend into next week.

Guilford County agencies are preparing for the weather event through increased staffing projections and validating resources are
