IC3 Overview

Mission

- Improve regional situational awareness
- Enhance regional coordination of information
- Improve coordination of regional information sharing among NCR jurisdictions and critical infrastructure partners

Objectives

- Identify regional priorities for information sharing
- Monitor emerging incidents and potential threats, and provide regionally-focused situational awareness
- Provide analysis of incidents for added value <u>beyond notification</u>
- Incorporate critical infrastructure and private sector impacts

Outputs

- RICCS-based Alert Messaging SPOT Reports based on CIR thresholds
- Dashboard Incident Management

<u>Major Duty Areas</u>: Monitor, Analyze, Information Dissemination, Coordination



Critical Information Requirements (CIR) Types


IC3 Performance Metrics - Jul - Oct 2017

- Top-5 NCR Reported CIRs:
 - 1. Transportation incidents impacting road, rail and air ways
 - 2. Adverse Weather Warnings for Thunderstorms, Floods and Tornados
 - 3. Non-CIR events as a result of International and National News or Exercise notifications
 - 4. Utility Outages for electricity, water, and communications
 - 5. CBRNE incidents as a result of EOD Team deployments
- IC3 Alert Metrics: Initial Notifications: 165, Non-CIRs: 20, Follow-Up Notifications: 247
- Triaged over 17,000 inbound alerts/ 5,700 per month
- Weekly Reports: 13 Reports; 130 Special Events and 26 Critical Infrastructure
- Four (4) SITREPs:
 - 2017 Independence Day Parade and Celebration (Initial and 2 Updates)
 - March to Confront White Supremacy
 - Nation's Triathlon
 - Fiesta DC-H Street Festival






EM Tech Summit 2017

City of Alexandria Congressional Shooting

- IC3 released 7 RICCS Alerts
 - Incident notification at ~7:30am on 6/14/2017
- Collected and coordinated info and messaging with:
 - FEMA-ONCRC / DC HSEMA JAHOC
 - VDEM
 - City of Alexandria OEM and VDEM Liaisons On-Scene
- Unit On-scene, reported to City of Alexandria EOC, then to JAHOC
- Migrated all messaging to Dashboard for Incident management - Sent Link to Mobile Dashboard
 - Incident remained Open until 6/19/2017
- Participated in AAR Interview Session (CNA)
