

# Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards

## CIP (Consolidated Information Processing) Board

*Incident Based*

(Version 2.0#)

**Description:** The CIP design consolidates the basic information flow for the NCR WebEOC installations to facilitate information sharing at the jurisdiction level utilizing a controller review component and, when appropriate, ability to share with the NCR. The board combines the Position Log, Controller Review and Awareness and Information into one board with multiple views, which enables functionality.

### ► Position Log (CIP)

**Views:** Users electronically log activities performed while active in their assigned position for an incident or exercise through the Position Log to enable users within the same position to review and share information to maintain continuity throughout an activation. The information entered may be sent for controller review if the user views the information as impacting or of importance for others outside the position.

**Display View** – This view shows all entries made by the position.

### Default Features

- *New Entry* button for creating a new position log entry.
- *Update* link for modifying a corresponding record's information.
- *Search* capability on the subject and description fields.
- Status background colors for easy identification of record's status. Green indicates the entry is closed and should not require further attention where red signifies the entry is open and is currently on-going.
- Event Priority background colors for easy identification of event priority. Red signifies Life Threatening and Yellow represents Critical.
- *Sent To* field to provide feedback, if the information was forwarded to the Controller, indicating where the information was further shared, as well as, the action taken (or not taken) by the Controller.
- *Feedback from Controller* field to receive communication from the WebEOC Controller regarding the entry.
- Actions dropdown that provides a link, *Print PDF*, to print the position log entries.

**Variation:** Loudoun County has additional copies of the view only list to facilitate position log sharing among two or more positions. Set filters are used to accomplish this sharing.

# Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards

**Variation:** Montgomery County uses the list view layout vs. the display view.

## Default Features

- *New Record* button for creating a new position log entry.
- *Edit* link for modifying a corresponding record's information.
- *Search* capability on the subject and description fields.
- Status background colors for easy identification of record's status. Green indicates the entry is closed and should not require further attention where red signifies the entry is open and is currently on-going.
- Event Priority background colors for easy identification of event priority. Red signifies Life Threatening and Yellow represents Critical.
- Filter dropdowns by Event Priority and Event Status.
- Montgomery County also displays the current EOC status in the upper right corner of the header.

**Input/Edit View** – This view enables the user to make position log entries and specify whether the data should be reviewed by the controller for further posting.

**Option 1:** Using a local controller for promoting to the local Awareness and Information board

**Option 2:** Same as above except the top portion for allowing for direct posts to the local Awareness and Information board.

## Default Features

- Date/Time picker code to facilitate proper date format
- Current Date/Time button to quickly populate with the current date/time
- Drop down lists to maintain data consistency
- Count down of available characters for the subject field
- Description field for additional information
- Option 1: Ability to send the entry for Controller Review for the post to be shared locally and to the NCR if applicable.
- Option 2: Ability to send the entry directly to the local Awareness and Information board and the option to send to the Controller to post to the NCR if applicable.
- Field flow from top to bottom to accommodate completing the form on a hand-held device.

## ► Controller Review (CIP)

The Controller Review section provides a mechanism for the designated controller position to review entries that were marked for controller review. The controller designates from here if the information should be posted to the local Awareness and Information board. The controller further designates if the information is promoted to the NCR Awareness and Information board.

**Views:** The Controller Review portion of the CIP includes a list view and a details section for vetting information and marking for promotion locally and, if appropriate, to the NCR.

**List View** – This view lists all position log entries forwarded to the controller for review for potential promotion within the jurisdiction (if using a controller for local Awareness and Information sharing) as well as to the NCR.

## Default Features

# Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards

- *Edit* link to review the details of the entry and take action on whether to promote the information or not.
- Status background colors for easy identification of current status
- Priority background colors for easy identification by the event priority.
- Filter buttons to limit the type of records displaying by the Event Status or by whether it is marked has being Significant.
- *New Entry* button to create an entry that can be promoted to the Awareness and Information and in the position log for the assigned position. This activity helps streamline activity during monitoring or smaller activations.
- *Search* capability on the subject and description fields
- Row color to identify records for review (yellow) and those reviewed (green).

**Input/Edit View (Controller)** – This view is for the controller to review the position log information submitted and make promotions to local and NCR Awareness and Information board.

# Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards

## Default Features

- Radio button options for posting or removing information to the local Awareness and Information board
- Radio button options for posting or removing information on the NCR’s Awareness and Information or NCR Exercise boards.
- Date/Time picker code to facilitate proper date format
- Current Date/Time button to quickly populate the field with the current date/time.
- Drop down lists to maintain data consistency
- Count down of available characters for the subject field

**Variation:** Fairfax County added checkboxes called “Confirmed” to indicate the information has been confirmed and “SitStat” to flag the entry to appear on the SitStat view.

## ► Awareness and Information (CIP)

The Awareness and Information portion of the CIP lists entries that were shared by other positions for the entire jurisdiction to view.

**Views:** The Awareness and Information views include a list view for high level review with a detail view for additional information. No direct entry is made to this board; all input originates from the position log (or Controller Review view).

**List View** – This view lists all promoted position log entries for the entire jurisdiction to view.

- Search capability on the reference number, subject, and description fields
- Data filtering by the status value through the “Filter By” dropdown list options

# Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards

- Data filtering for records indicated as significant.
- *View link* to access additional details.
- Status background colors for easy identification of a record's status. Green indicates the record has been "Closed" and red signifies the record is "Open" and is currently on-going.
- Priority background colors for easy identification of an event's priority. Yellow indicates "Critical" and red signifies the event status is "Life Threatening"

**Variation:** Some jurisdictions offer the ability to view or hide National Weather Service Current Watches/Warnings from the local Awareness and Information view.
