# **Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards**

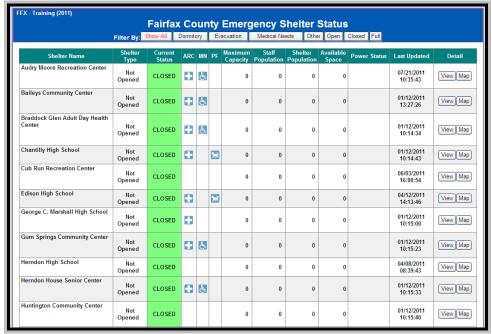
### Shelters Board (Version 1.0)

Incident Independent

**Description:** This board captures shelter status as well as shelter specifics—name, location, power source, whether Red Cross certified, pet friendly capacity, and available spaces.

**Views:** This board provides two input documents for designated positions. One is to add a shelter and its base information. The other input document is the activation edit for changing the status of the shelter and providing staffing and population numbers. There are multiple list views based on the accessibility level granted.

**List view** – This view lists all the entered shelters for the jurisdiction.



#### **Default Features**

- Data filtering by shelter type or shelter status by selecting the corresponding filter button
- View button to access additional shelter details
- Status background colors for easy identification of a record's status
- Mapping capability

Variations: Locality Filter. Prince William County hosts two localities on their system and they share the shelter board. Therefore there is a filter by Locality.

## **Supported Local Core WebEOC Boards**

**Input/Edit View** There are two views depending on access for editing shelter information. One is for adding/modifying the basic shelter information and the other is for supply additional detail information if the shelter is activated.



### **Default Features**

- Drop down lists to maintain data consistency
- Spell Check button to ensure correct spelling
- Mapper Enabled

Variations: Locality dropdown field. Prince William County hosts two other localities and they share the shelter board. Therefore there is a dropdown field to specify the locality for the shelter.
