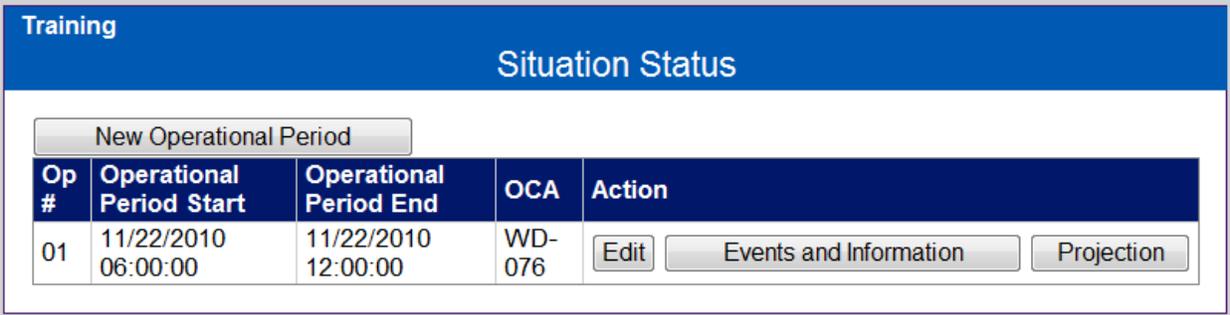

Tonight: Areas of blowing snow and a chance of snow showers before 1am, then areas of blowing snow and a slight chance of snow showers after 1am. Cloudy, with a low around 14. Wind chill values as low as zero. Northwest wind between 14 and 16 mph. Chance of precipitation is 30%. New snow accumulation of 4 to 6 inches possible.
