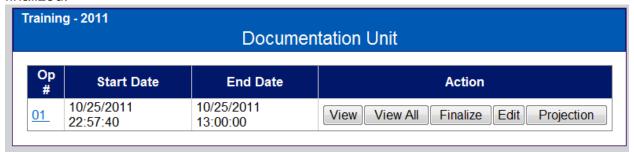

Incident Dependent

Description: This board documents EOC Priorities, EOC Objectives, and notes in the following areas: EOC Briefing, General, Goals Development, Objectives Development, Progress Assessment, Policy Group Progress Briefing and Other for each operational period throughout an incident.

Views: There is only one list view for creating and viewing operational periods. Then within each operational period each document area can be accessed.

List View – This view lists the operational periods. The ability to create a new record can only be accomplished once the prior document (operation period) has been finalized.



Default Features

- Edit/View button to view/edit a selected document.
- View All button to see a complete report of all the different briefings/notes.
- The ability to lock documents from being further created/modified through the Finalize button
- The ability to display the board as a *Projection* view with larger fonts for viewing from a display wall.

Variations: None

Input View – This view records the operational period number and the start and end date/times corresponding to the operational period.

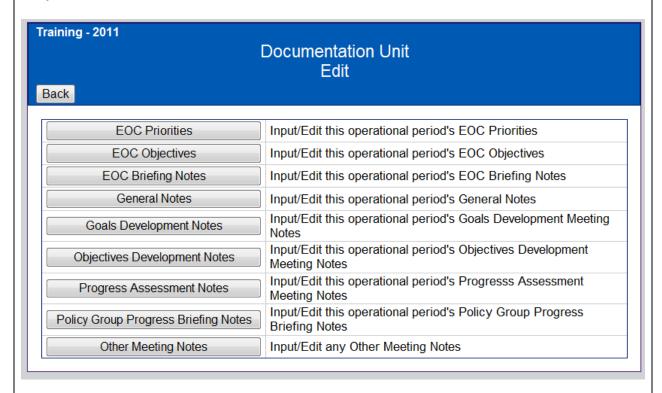
Default Features
