Situation Report Board (ESF based w/questions) (Ver. 1.0) Incident Dependent

Description: This board provides situation documentation for each operational period conducted.

Views: There are multiple list views. One for creating and operational period and editing all entries and others for each ESF. The inputs are based on the list view displayed.

List View – This view lists operational periods established with buttons to view or edit the corresponding situation report.

Default Features

- *Edit* button to edit the selected record’s situation report.
- *View* button to see a noneditable view of the data.

Variation: See Situation Report – Dynamic

Variation: The City of Fairfax provides views by agency with specific questions within the coded view for prompts.

Variation: The WMATA version prompts all groups the same questions and their view is position based.

Input/Edit View (Creator/Reviewer) – This view enables new situation reports to be created for entry. Only the first three fields need to be completed to create a situation report. The other fields are for the reviewer to review each area and edit information as appropriate.

Default Features:

- Date/Time pkcer code to facilitate proper date format.
- *Spell Check* button to ensure correct spelling

Variations: See Situation Report – Dynamic

Input/Edit View (ESF Representative) – This view enables the ESF representative to complete their section of data. Prompts are provided to guide the user’s response. Users need to be trained to answer in complete sentences and not just provide answers to the questions as they do not display with the report.

1. How many road closures (please describe)?
2. Any signal problems (please describe)?
3. Any structural damage (please describe)?
4. Any water-main breaks (please describe)?
5. How many downed trees?
6. How many signals are out?
7. Are there any infrastructure concerns?
8. Was mutual aid enacted? Who, what, where?
9. What are your resource/deployment needs?
10. What have you deployed (how many and what type)?
11. Were EMAC requests made?
12. What is the impact to ESF-1 over the next 24 hours (operational status issues / concerns)?

- *Spell check* button to ensure correct spelling
