### Features

This board offers many NCR standard features which include:

- Sorting the data by the jurisdiction name. The sort is activated by clicking on the jurisdiction column header.
- Viewing additional details by clicking the *View* button associated with the record.
- Identifying status information by utilizing colored cells for the status. Green means something is done and should not require further attention where yellow red signifies something is currently on-going and should be noted. Yellow is more minor where red indicates a notable status.
- Editing can be performed by a position/user that has been identified and provided with rights to do so (if the button is not visible to a given user, then that user has not been granted rights to modify the jurisdiction information.). Jurisdictions should only modify their respective data.
- The jurisdiction colors will change to gray if the last update field age is beyond 24 hours.
