


<p>Description: This board captures event/facility information for displaying on a map.</p>															
<p>Views: This board provides two list views—one for viewing with access to the input/edit views, and the other for view only with no input/edit access.</p>															
<p>List View – This view lists all the entered events/facilities that are being noted for the current incident.</p>
