



# Supported Specialty WebEOC Boards

Event Mapping Board (Version 1.0)	Incident Dependent														
<p><b>Description:</b> This board captures event/facility information for displaying on a map.</p>															
<p><b>Views:</b> This board provides two list views—one for viewing with access to the input/edit views, and the other for view only with no input/edit access.</p>															
<p><b>List View</b> – This view lists all the entered events/facilities that are being noted for the current incident.</p>

<p>This view deployed to Loudoun County and Prince William County relocated the Map button next to the Edit button.</p>															
<p><b>Input/Edit View</b> - The input/edit view enables input of events/facilities that have noteworthy activity or events that are listed and can be displayed on a map for situational awareness.</p>
