

Supported Specialty WebEOC Boards

Health Care Status Board (Version 1.0) *Incident Independent Based*

Description: This board provides a mechanism to capture pre-identified health care facilities and related statuses.

Views: This board uses various lists displaying the same information. They vary in the buttons available that drive access permissions.

List View – This view displays the health care facilities entered along with the various status information. The fields are color coded such that green is good or normal, yellow means there is something unusual or a minor issue and red means there is an issue. When the facility name, type, last update and comments fields appear in grey, this is an indicator that the information is not current.
