Default Features:

- *Return to Incidents* button to go back to the incident listing.
- *Create New Contact* button to record a new notification group.
- Search capability on the Contact Group, Contact ID, Contact Name, Contact Phone, Contact Email, Contact Notes and Contact Department fields.
- *Update* button to edit the contact information.

Variation: Prince William (Manassas/Manassas Park) displays Jurisdiction, Last Name, First Name, Agency and Email address on their list view.

Contact Edit/Enter View: This view enables the user to enter/edit contact information. Each record is for one individual and uses the Contact Group drop down to associate with a group.
