NIMS Compliance Tracking Board (Version 1.0) Incident Independent

Description: This board provides a mechanism to track NIMS Compliance Training.

Views: This board uses a list view for displaying employees within a department and status information for each ICS class. There is also a dashboard view where the information is aggregated and displayed to provide decision makers insight on the status of the various metrics.

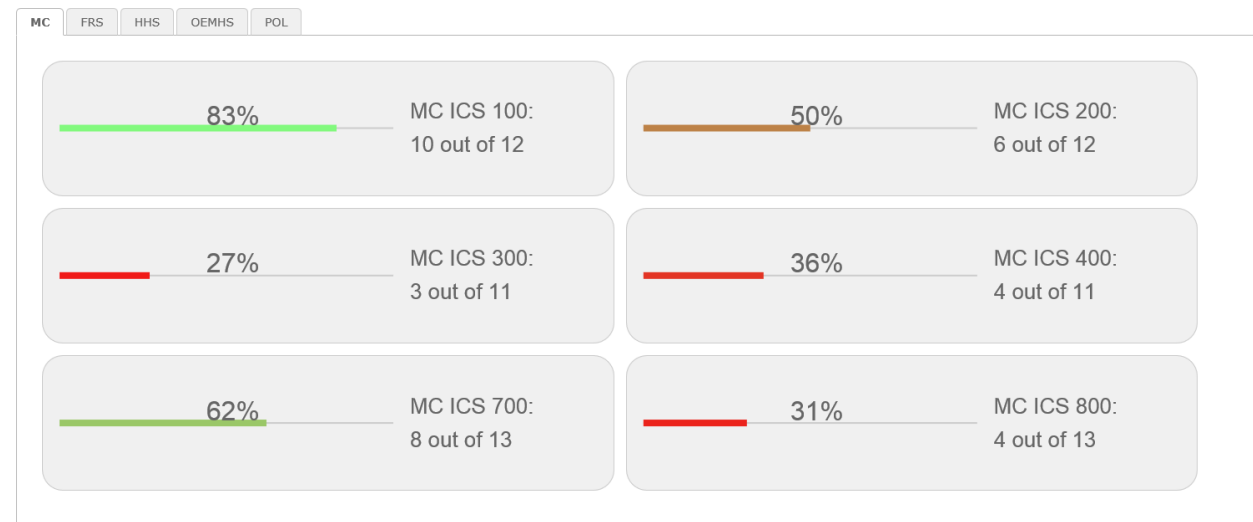
